## **TOBACCO AND VAPOUR PRODUCTS**

#### **Smoking and Vaping Glamorized on the Screens**

The annual Truth Initiative's report "While You Were Streaming: Nicotine on Demand" analyzed tobacco imagery across the 15 most popular streaming shows among 15- to 24-year-olds and found that 60% of their favorite new releases and 64% of the top binge-watched shows included tobacco depictions.

It also found that 23% of the top 2020 Billboard songs <u>featured smoking and vaping in their music videos</u>, totaling over 6 billion views on YouTube alone. This is concerning as research shows that young people are <u>3x more likely</u> to start vaping when exposed to tobacco imagery in popular streaming and TV shows.



#### What can educators do?

- -Discuss the impact of exposure to imagery and advertising with students to encourage awareness, critical thinking and advocacy
- -Check this database to confirm if tobacco or vaping is depicted in a movie or series
- -Include vaping and smoking media literacy in your teaching using resources from Smoke Free Movies; Smokefree Media; Common Sense; & Media Smarts

On March 16 Health Canada opened a public consultation regarding the <u>Tobacco and Vaping Products Act</u> (TVPA) as part of its legislative review process. They are looking for perspectives on the operation of the vaping-related provisions of the TVPA, with a particular emphasis on protecting young persons.
